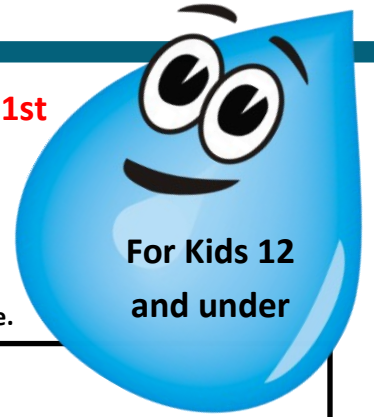

3. Picture must relate to the theme, “we use water wisely”. Show us how you try to conserve water at home or at school. Feel free to use words in your drawing. Please use one color (markers or ink pen work best).

5. Entries must be received by Wednesday, October 31, 2018 and cannot be returned.
6. Entries will be judged on the basis of originality, adherence to the theme and overall design by a panel of NCWD employees and commissioners. Winners will be notified by September 30, 2018.
7. One Grand-Prize winner and 4 runner ups will be selected.
8. Grand Prize winner’s artwork will be featured on the NCWD reusable bags and he/she will receive a water conservation T-shirt. The winner agrees to allow North City Water District to publish his/her name (first name, last initial only), age and artwork on North City Water District reusable canvas bags. Bags will be distributed with conservation materials at community events and festivals through out the year.
9. Runner up winners will be featured in the District’s newsletter and website and will receive a Water Conservation T-shirt .
10. All contest entrants agree to allow NCWD to use their drawings in newsletters or on our website.
11. All materials received will become the property of NCWD and will not be returned. NCWD will not be responsible for entries that are damaged or lost in the mail.
