#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

- a. CIP 2022-41 Beach Drive Crossing Project Easement.
  - <u>ACTION</u>: Commissioner Haines moved to: (a) accept the easement signed by Sheridan Beach Community Club (SBCC); (b) approve the compensation agreement with SBCC and authorize Ms. Pottinger to sign on behalf of the District; and (c) direct Ms. Pottinger to record the easement at King County. Commissioner Hale seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
- **b.** Sensus Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Agreement. Mr. Woody explained the background. <u>ACTION</u>: Upon motion by Commissioner Haines and second by Commissioner Hale, the Board approved the AMI Agreement with Sensus and authorized Ms. Pottinger to sign on behalf of the District.
