

Chapter 5: BANKRUPTCIES

2.05.010 Debt Not Eliminated by Bankruptcy Filing.

Bankruptcy does not eliminate the filer's responsibility for billing subsequent to the bankruptcy filing date. Such billings are subject to normal billing practices including being subject to penalties and termination. (Res. 2009.04.18)

2.05.020 Discharge or Dismissals of Bankruptcies.

Upon notification from the bankruptcy court that the case has been either dismissed or discharged, all amount owing that were frozen by the bankruptcy notice become current charges and due. Collection efforts for all balances may resume according to District billing policies. (Res. 2009.04.18)
