

## **Chapter 6: LIENS**

- A. The board of commissioners authorizes the district manager to file liens against properties for which connections charges or water service payments in the amount of \$250.00 or more are delinquent for more than sixty days and have been shut off. Such liens shall include interest, penalties, recording costs as establish by King County, attorneys' fees, and other applicable fees or charges, as allowed by law.
- B. The board of commissioners further authorizes the district manager to certify and file the liens with the King County comptroller, as required by law.
- C. The district manager shall periodically report to the board of commissioners on the status or the actions taken pursuant to this resolution.
- D. The district manager shall also have the authority to release a lien that has been satisfied in full. (Res 2018.08.22)
