

In an effort to significantly lower the risk of exposure to lead and copper in our nation's drinking water, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is requiring all Water Utilities to perform a Lead Service Line Inventory, and provide the results to the EPA.

SURVEY: Lead Pipe Service Line Inventory

North City Water District has never used lead in our service lines from the main to the meter, and King County banned the use of lead service lines in the late 1960s. However, if your home was built during or before 1970, it could have lead pipe in the customer-owned section of underground water line (as per the above diagram). Please complete this survey to help us gather critical information about your water service line, so we can avoid the need to dig up your property to assess the lines directly.
